On March 12, 13, and 14 of this year, during the NCPH-ASEH Portland conference, Portland Baroque Orchestra is producing a set of concerts of historically informed concerts of Baroque music, played on original 18th-century instruments or replicas made using historical techniques. One of the world's finest recorder players, Matthias Maute from Germany, will be joined by English violinist Monica Huggett (PBO's artistic director) performing virtuoso music by Baroque composer Antonio Vivaldi.
