



The History Department at the University of Missouri-Kansas City is seeking an **Assistant Professor**, tenure-track, nine-month position beginning August 2012 in **Public History**. The Ph.D. in History or a related field must be completed by the time of employment. The successful candidate should be committed to a sustained agenda of research, publication, and community engagement. All subfields will be considered but the preferred candidate will contribute to Black Studies or Latina/o Studies (a joint appointment is also possible). Beyond the resources of the university, the successful candidate will also have access to a variety of public and private museums, archives, and libraries that mark Kansas City as a dynamic urban center. Candidates must send a letter of interest, vita, graduate transcripts, three letters of recommendation, and a writing sample or public history project overview.
