The Department of Comparative Cultural Studies (CCS) at Northern Arizona University seeks to hire an Assistant Professor of Practice in Arts and Cultural Management for an academic year position, commencing in Fall 2018, contracted yearly and renewable based on enrollment needs and contingent on effective performance and available funding. Responsibilities include the equivalent of four courses per semester (one course equivalent will be assigned to supervising all CCS internships) and service responsibilities as assigned by the Chair in the Department of Comparative Cultural Studies.

- One year of experience with instructional design, outreach and/or teaching at an arts or cultural institution or a college/university
- Five years of professional experience in arts and cultural management

  - Evidence of practical experience in community engagement and outreach
  - Demonstrated commitment to working with diverse populations on campus and in the community
